TIPS TO STAY ON THE MOVE:



Choose a birth **setting** that encourages movement

interventions that limit movement, like

Plan for continuous support during labor

MAX OUT YOUR LABOR **POWER** AND **TRY THESE POSITIONS**:



Standing, supported squat: allows baby to descend



painful contractions



Side-lying: may make contractions more effective



Squatting: can increase pelvic diameter up to 2cm
